### EOC Intervention

End-of-Course intervention for KISD students who fail the STAAR End-of-Course Exam will occur on each of the high school campuses. Students will be contacted once scores are received. Students are provided opportunities to participate in End of Course Intervention courses on their home campus. Students *WILL NOT* earn credit for a class in EOC Intervention.

<b>SUPPLIES</b>	Students are expected to arrive at school on the first day of class prepared with pen and paper.
<b>DRESS CODE</b>	The school dress code as stated in the KISD Student Code of Conduct will be in effect. No tank, midriff, or halter tops. No cut-offs will be allowed. Shorts, skorts must fall between fingertips and knuckles and the skirts must be at least fingertip length. Clothing considered to be gang-related attire or with objectionable language or artwork will not be allowed. Hats, bandanas and other head coverings will not be allowed. Shoes are required. House shoes are not appropriate. Students found in violation of the dress code will be sent home and their absences unexcused.
<b>ATTENDANCE</b>	Students should be on time and in attendance each day.
<b>DISCIPLINE</b>	Students will follow campus rules and classroom rules. Inappropriate behavior will result in the student being referred to the summer principal. Two referrals during a session may result in the student being dropped from summer intervention program.
<b>TRANSPORTATION</b>	Transportation <u>will not</u> be provided for EOC intervention.

### ONLINE ACCELERATION

The High School summer program offers opportunities for students to accelerate their course work through Texas Virtual School Network (TxVSN). Students may register at their home campuses for the online courses they would like to take after completing an online pre-assessment. 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### Credit Recovery

High School Summer Registration will occur online through the KISD webstore. Computers are available for registration in the campus counseling office.

Students will

- Be assigned a virtual teacher monitor
- Complete one course at a time (additional courses are possible)
- Contact virtual monitor when there is a concern or question
- Complete all coursework independently up to the final exam, which must be taken at Central High School (see dates below)
- Have weekly check-ins by the virtual monitor

**All coursework must be completed by July 10, 2018.**

### **CREDIT RECOVERY**

Students are allowed the opportunity to recover credit for courses that they have previously taken by completing the course through the **Edgenuity** computer curriculum. The course work is self-paced and completed by the student independently with access to a virtual certified instructor to assist each student through the curriculum. Taking these courses does not guarantee credit. These courses are challenging and it is always our recommendation that if a student did not grasp the basic concepts that they retake the course during the school year. Grades in credit recovery are awarded in the form of a P or F. Students can complete up to 2 full credits if time allows.

**Please note: Any credits earned via the Edgenuity credit recovery curriculum will not meet eligibility guidelines for students wishing to compete in NCAA athletics in college. See your counselor for additional information.**
